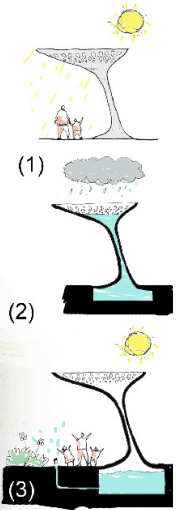

Comments jury (Jan Krause, Felipe Duque, Lieven De Neve):

The idea of using fibre cement as a landscape element demonstrates the ecological qualities of the EPD certified material. The free forming character of fibre cement, known from planting vessels and outdoor furniture has been transferred here into a larger scale without losing its sculptural power. The proposal proves in an impressive way, that fibre cement is an important material for sustainable planning of buildings and landscapes.

Above all the elegant and consequent way the candidate has elaborated his idea has charmed us. The at first sight simple model, seems to be very well studied. The candidate must have a very good knowledge on fibre cement and its characteristics such as sustainability.

The candidate has created new applications for fibre cement where new and complex shapes can be created.

In the concerned design the architect has created the need to develop more durable materials.
